Governments and open data

- Relationship status: "Complicated"
- "Open by default", but...
 - Cold feet: quality, liability, ...
 - Same discussions as first websites, open source ...
 - = => Explain, challenge (and be patient)
- Local / regional / national / EU portals
 - DCAT-AP metadata exchange to the rescue
 - Communication across administrations is key



What do businesses want?

- Availability + Updates + Continuity
 - Publishing data only once (see: hackathons) doesn't help
 - Will it still be there next year(s)?
- Hard to keep track who is using open data
 - By definition: access control =/= open data
 - Data-centric companies existed before "open data"
 - Remember: adminstrations are (re)users as well
